

Henderson Wiffleball Classic COVID-19 Plan

Physical activity and charitable giving is vital to our community. It is of the utmost importance to do so safely. It is the goal of the Henderson Wiffleball Classic organizers to implement the best and safest protocols possible. It is the goal of this document to outline the measures that will be taken to protect the people participating in the event in accordance with state and county guidelines.

Our event is a low touch event. The wiffleball tournament is charitable event benefiting the Henderson Boys & Girls Club. The event is held outdoors. The goal of this event is to promote physical activity while raising funds to benefit a worthy cause.

Social Distancing & Personal Protective Equipment:

- This event will be held at the Henderson County Fairgrounds, which is an outdoor venue. The entire parcel is nearly 18 acres.
- Adequate social distancing will be provided and encouraged.
 1. Teams will be limited to five (5) people. These teams will sit separately and be more than (six) 6 feet apart. (See map)
 2. Fields will be spaced so that teams playing will be separated from the teams not playing. (See map)
 3. All booths will be adequately spaced to allow for social distancing. (See map)
- The players will have little to no contact with each other.
- Spectators will be encouraged to social distance in the green space provided.
- Spectators will not be allowed on the playing field.
- Congregation of participants will be discouraged.
- Unnecessary physical contact will be discouraged.
- Masks will be required when social distancing is not possible. This may be required when signing players in and distributing t-shirts.
- Needed volunteers will be kept to a minimum.

Sanitation:

- All equipment will be sanitized before use (plastic bats and balls).
- All plastic balls and bats will be sanitized after every game.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at booths.
- Handwashing will be encouraged.
- The concession stand will not provide buffet style food.

Screening and Illness Checks:

- All players will have their temperature taken before being allowed to play. Players exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms or registering a body temperature exceeding one hundred (100) degrees, will not be allowed to participate.
- All players will be required to certify that they have no commonly known COVID-19 related symptoms such as shortness of breath, cough, loss of taste or smell, and muscle aches.
- All players must provide name, address, and phone number.
- All communication of rules will be provided via the event's social media platforms and website.

Compliance:

- If any player does not comply with the Henderson Wiffleball Classic Plan, they will be required to leave with no refund.
- If players and or teams are noncompliant, the organizers will contact local law enforcement.
